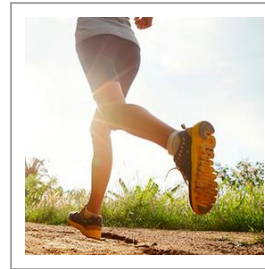
- Candia was represented on the Lamprey River All Star Team, runner up in NH State LL
